



TENNIS FACILITY USE STATEMENT

House Rules

All Players of Tennis and Platform Tennis are required to abide by the posted rules and policies

Guest Policy: A non-member may generally be a guest of a Member at the tennis/platform tennis courts a maximum of two days a month whether or not his or her host is different each time, however house guests may use the tennis/platform courts an unlimited number of times as long as the member is present and pays a guest fee for each use. Renters are not house guests. Please be sure to sign in guests prior to play. Guest Fee is \$10/per guest.

Dress Policy: All white clothing must be worn on the tennis courts at all times.

Phone Usage: Cell phone use is prohibited on the tennis and platform tennis courts and building (please limit cell phone use to the parking lot).

Court Openings/Closing: Play may not begin before 8:30 am and should conclude by dusk.

Reservations System: Members are asked to always reserve courts prior to arriving at the facility for play.

Court Closures: In the event of rain or court maintenance staff will notify members of court closures via the online reservation system and email communication.

Standing Court Reservations: Members may create one standing, weekly, seasonal court reservation for groups of members to play.

Court Maintenance: Members wishing to play beyond 7 pm on weekdays and 5 pm on weekends during the regular season are asked to sweep and line their own court. Before Memorial Day and after Labor Day members are asked to sweep and line courts after play, unless otherwise directed by a staff member.

Instructional Use: The tennis professional and members of CYC tennis staff are solely responsible for providing instruction to members and guests at the tennis facility. Guests may not bring instructors to the courts for lessons.

Trash/Recycling: Members are asked to police their own trash, balls, and recyclable materials prior to leaving the facility.

Staff Fill-Ins: Tennis staff are available to fill in for members who need subs for their regular groups. Requests should be sent to the Director of Tennis 24 hours in advance. Last minute requests will be taken on a case-by-case basis. This service should be used sparingly and only in emergency situations when all other options have been exhausted. Members will be billed \$30 for staff fill-ins.

Child Supervision: The staff is not responsible for supervising children while parents play tennis.

Animals: No dogs are allowed on the premises.

Transportation: Please drive slowly and abide by all posted speed and traffic signs coming to and going from the courts. The posted speed limit in the Shoreby Hill neighborhood is 15 mph.
